Is your dog friendly, gentle, and well-mannered? If so, you and your dog may work together to touch the lives of those in need by being a Warm Hearts team!

To qualify for evaluation,
your dog must:

- ✓ Be one year or older
- ✓ Have been a part of your family for 6 months or more
- ✓ Display exceptional behavior and personality traits
- ✓ Be extraordinarily tolerant
