Summer can be a dangerous time for your pets.

If you have left your pet in a hot car or playing outside for a significant amount of time watch for signs of heat stroke, which include extreme panting, difficulty breathing, vomiting, diarrhea, confusion, rapid pulse, bright red gums and blue tongue or lips. If your pet exhibits signs of heat stroke move them to a cool place and contact your veterinarian immediately for further treatment.
