Animal Humane's Donor-subsidized Veterinary Clinic provides preventative care services for needs-based qualified clientele. Although our pricing is reduced compared to industry standards, **this is not a free clinic**; fees are associated with all services and payment is due at the time of service. Clients must qualify for veterinary services.

## Hours of Operation

Spay/neuter patients are taken on an appointment only basis **Monday through Thursday**. Please arrive at 7:30 am on the day of your appointment for surgical check-in.

Patients are seen by appointment only. If you have an urgent need, please seek emergency veterinary care. Please note that we are neither a full-service emergency hospital, nor are we equipped to handle walk-in emergency appointments.

Our Clinic is closed on Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays.

## What Proof of Income do I need?

- By verbally providing your household income to our Team upon check-in, you agree that you qualify for services according to the needs-based guidelines to the right.

## Price List for Clinic Services

### Spay/Neuter Surgeries:

\***Non-routine spay/neuter procedures** may incur additional fees that range from \$20 - \$150 contingent upon sex, age, species, and surgical complications such as pet being in heat, pregnant or testicles not being fully descended.

## Individual Services & Products offered for Dogs and Cats

Vaccinations & blood work may be performed on surgery day, if needed.

- RCP respiratory complex for cats.....\$20
- DA2PP distemper/parvo complex for dogs.....\$20
- Bordetella vaccine for dogs.....\$20
- Rabies 1 year vaccine for cats and dogs.....\$18
- \*Puppies and kittens in their first year need a series of 3 vaccines every 3-4 weeks from 6 to 16 weeks (about 4 months) of age*
- Microchip.....\$25
- Heartworm test (dogs).....\$15
- FeLV/FIV test (cats).....\$25
- Elizabethan collar.....\$12

The Albuquerque Heart Ordinance requires that all pets be sterilized, vaccinated against rabies, licensed, and microchipped. **In compliance with the Heart Ordinance, all patients receiving veterinary care at Animal Humane New Mexico’s Donor-subsidized Veterinary Clinic will be sterilized and vaccinated against rabies.** Proof of rabies certificate is required at the time of drop-off. If none is provided to us and your pet is of age to receive the inoculation, a rabies vaccine will be administered for \$18 that same day.
